#### Invitation to Parents of children in Year R (Reception)

#### P.E Information

Just a reminder that children are required to wear their P.E kit to school on the days they have P.E or sports club.

#### Their uniform is:

- P.E shirt with school logo or a plain white t-shirt.
- Black shorts.
- Black plimsolls.
- White or black socks.
- Additional sweatshirt and black leggings or tracksuit for winter.
- Trainers for Key stage 2 outside P.E.
- For safety reasons,
- All long hair must be tied back.
- Children who have their ears pierced should only wear plain studs and these must be covered for P.E. Please do this before your child comes to school or supply them with micropore tape for them to cover them themselves.
- All watches, including Fitbits and other sports watches must be removed for P.E lessons.
- Children who need glasses for P.E must have a strap to secure them in place.

#### **Attendance Matters**

The DfE have issued new statutory guidance for school attendance. This is part of the national drive to address low school attendance rates across the country since the return from Covid. There are some important changes for you to be aware of:

- -Firstly, I am now unable to grant absence for a holiday. This was already severely restricted but now the code H which we used in the register when holiday in term time was granted no longer exists. This means that any request that would previously have been a term-time holiday request must now be an **exceptional leave of absence request** in which you must detail why the planned absence is exceptional. Beyond funerals and severe family illness, there is very little leeway for me to grant this absence. Weddings, for example, are specifically excluded.
- -Importantly, I am now no longer able to grant an exceptional leave of absence retrospectively. This means that if you don't seek permission on the appropriate form for an absence before it begins, I am obliged to record it as an **Unauthorised Absence**. It may be that this is paving the way for the DfE to further strengthen its policy on parental fines (which have recently been increased) so please bear this in mind!
- -Finally, and very importantly for many of our parents, a request for exceptional leave of absence can only be made by a parent with whom the child normally resides. This appears to mean that, for example, in a split family where the child lives entirely with Mum, the Dad cannot submit an absence request; it must come from the Mum even if the absence will be taken by the child and Dad. If residence is shared, our new guidance seems to indicate that either parent can put a request in.

Please remember these aren't my rules, they come from the Department for Education.
