Morning Drop offs

With the rising numbers of Covid cases locally, we are keeping our procedures under constant review and we have noticed that there is congestion at about 8:40 in the morning on the school drive. Teaching Assistants arriving by car have been requested to arrive before 8:45, which is already 15 minutes before their start time, when the drive is then closed to them. A number of parents are arriving very early for drop offs which is causing congestion and compromising social distancing. Can we remind all parents to arrive no earlier than five minutes before their drop off time. This will allow each bubble to enter the building without parent's safety being compromised by a lack of space. Can I also request you observe social distancing whilst waiting in the queues. Of course, you can wear face coverings, if it makes you feel more comfortable. We have a number of adults who have to be very careful for health reasons and need to drop their children off and we want to protect our whole school community.
