Unfortunate Series of Heating Events

Thank you all for your patience yesterday and sincere apologies for any inconvenience caused. On Monday we had the bizarre coincidence with all three independent heating systems failing for different parts of the school for different reasons despite the fact that they had been working before half term. We have had heating engineers, plumbers, control panel specialists and heating flushing specialists all trying to get the three systems up and working again. It was not confirmed that we would have hot water until 4.30pm. The hire company could only confirm the heaters could be delivered before school this morning at 4.40pm which is why a decision could not be made until late afternoon. The contractors have all been extremely helpful and made us their priority to ensure that we were only closed for one day. The result is that we had managed to get the boilers in the original school building and in Key Stage 1 working and we have hired powerful fan heaters for the six classrooms that have no heating until the problems with the other boilers can be properly resolved. We would like to thank all the contractors and fan hire company for all their help and expertise.

Y3 Wildside

We were very disappointed that we had to cancel the visits for Year 3 today and on Friday. We took this decision as we had not received voluntary contributions from over 25% of the pupils and our budget cannot continue to support such large shortfalls.
