#### **URGENT NOTICE OF SCHOOL CLOSURE**

**AS** you are aware, there is currently an amber weather warning in place as storm Ciaran moves towards Devon. An amber warning presents a risk to life, but there is also a large amount of uncertainty about this weather front which means it could increase to a red warning overnight. The combination of wind, rain, and the storm moving over warm sea waters increases risk of very high wind speeds, flooding and trees falling.

Devon County Council have asked all staff where possible to work from home, and for schools to strongly consider closing. Based on this information, we have made the decision to close the school tomorrow to ensure the safety of the whole school community.

We appreciate this may put parents and carers in a difficult situation, but ultimately, we will not compromise the safety of our pupils, their families, and our staff.
