Safeguarding - From time to time the school may need to make referrals to Children and Young People's Services

Children's Holiday Club (HAF - Holidays Activity & Food Programme) Culm Valley Sports Centre

The aim of the HAF programme is to support children to eat more healthily, be more active over the school holidays and have a greater knowledge of health and nutrition as well as be more engaged with school and other local services.

This club runs Monday 19^{th} – Thursday 22^{nd} December, 10am – 2pm for ages 5 - 12, and 3pm - 7pm for ages 12 - 16.

There are a limited funded places available that allow children in receipt of benefit related FSM (Free School Meals) a free place. There are also funded places for vulnerable families that may not be in receipt of FSM, children with SEND requirements and children in Foster care. The holiday club is also available to other families for £25 per child per day.

Annual Consultation - Changes to Catchment Area

This is the annual opportunity for parents to review the admissions arrangements that are proposed and to comment on them, making suggestions for change. This is of especial importance to parents this year, as part of the consultation is to decide whether Willand School will be placed into the catchment areas for both Uffculme School and Cullompton Community College. This would mean that when your child is transferring to Secondary School you would be guaranteed a place in either of these schools.

Devon's annual consultation on School Admission Arrangements 2024/2025 is now running and will close on **Friday 6 January 2023.**
