If your child requires medication such as antibiotics, you will need to bring this in to the school office each morning and remember to collect it from the office at the end of the day. It is helpful if you can also provide a medicine spoon.

New Year's Resolution

Please can you support your child's learning this term by making sure they are doing their daily reading at home. Details for Reception children will be shared later this term. All children from Year 1 upwards are expected to read at home each weekday evening. The children from year 3 and upwards, all read for 30 minutes per day in school and this needs to be supplemented by 20 minutes or at least 10 pages per night in years 3-6. THIS IS THE MOST IMPORTANT HOMEWORK TO COMPLETE AS IT IS A BASIS FOR ALL THEIR OTHER LEARNING AND HELPS THEM BUILD THEIR VOCABULARY.
