#### **Healthy Snacks at Breaktime**

## 'Free Speech v Hate Speech'

Contentious or provocative viewpoints are shared every second of the day online That's not to say, however, that an opinion is less valid simply because it's initially unpopular: just think about Galileo or Emmeline Pankhurst. The facility to have our beliefs questioned — and to challenge other people's in return — is often a catalyst for scientific and social progress With disturbing frequency, though, some individuals post damaging hate speech online under the guise of 'freedom of expression' — and unless young people can identify hate speech, there's a risk of them being influenced by such harmful content. Our #WakeUpWednesday guide explores the crucial differences between free speech and hate speech.
