Children's Mental Health Week and Safer Internet Day

Next week it's children's Mental Health Week (6th-12th February). This year's theme is 'Let's Connect'. As it's also Safer Internet Day on Tuesday 7th February we will be combining the two events and encouraging the children to talk about their experiences and how they can connect safely online with others. The children will talk about how we can connect emotionally and physically, learn ways to keep mentally healthy and some classes will be taking part in mindfulness workshops. We will also be having a 'Dress to Express' day on Thursday 9th February. Children can come to school wearing their home clothes on this day but if your child has PE, please make sure they are still appropriately dressed for this.

School Lunches

Just a reminder that the Dinner Money Arrears Policy says that for accounts that are in debt by £15 or more the school will ask you to provide your child with a packed lunch until the debt has been cleared. This is the total amount owing for the family, not for individual children. If you request further lunches without clearing the account your child will be given a school packed lunch for which you will be charged the full lunch price, which is currently £2.40.

I would like to take this opportunity to remind you that all lunches must be paid for in advance.
