Industrial Action Thursday 2nd March

Over the last week I have conducted a risk assessment and consulted the Chair of Governors and the decision has been reached that the school will once again need be closed to the majority of pupils, as unfortunately it cannot be guaranteed there will be sufficient staff to cover the children to attend school. (It is important for parents to understand that employment law does not require staff to notify the school of their intentions regarding industrial action).

As before, most children will need to remain at home and will not be able to attend school under any circumstances. Later this week we will be contacting those who we can accommodate but unfortunately we will not be able to include critical worker children as there are simply not enough staff to safely open the school for them.

On the day of the strike, we will not be able to offer online lessons, however there are a range of excellent resources available on the Internet, including BBC bite-size and the National Oak Academy.

It is possible that some staff may form a picket line outside the school. A picket line is where staff gather near the entrance to a workplace to protest in person and may be holding placards or banners. If that is the case, we would like to take this opportunity to remind all children, parents and carers that as a school we respect our staff's legal right to strike. Please ensure that any interactions you have with staff are as courteous and respectful as they would be on any other day.

If your child is usually entitled to benefits related free school meals we can provide a lunch for Thursday. We will contact you about this. (This does not include the Universal Free School Meals to which all Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 children are entitled.)

I appreciate that any closure may be disruptive for you but we hope that you understand that we, as a school, have had to take decisions to secure the health and safety of your child(ren) and any non-striking staff in consideration of anticipated reduced numbers of staffing.

Should the industrial dispute be resolved we will of course be open as usual.

Absence During Term Time

If you are thinking of taking your child out of school during term time, for any length of time, you <u>must</u> complete an absence request form <u>before</u> going away. The advice from Devon County Council is that 'parents should ensure that they know whether the absence will be authorised or not before they go away as an unauthorised absence will likely result in a penalty notice or court summons being issued to each parent for each pupil affected. It is therefore recommended that this completed form is sent into the school at least three school weeks before the intended absence.' Forms are available to download from the website or to collect from the school office.
