Free School Meals

Free School Meals eligibility is **benefit-related only** and to be eligible you need to be in receipt of one or more of the following benefits:-

Universal Credit (provided you have an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400, as assessed by earnings from up to three of your most recent assessment periods) **Income Support** (IS)

Income-based Jobseekers Allowance (IBJSA) Income-related Employment and Support Allowance (IRESA)

The guaranteed element of Pension Credit

Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999

Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income that does not exceed £16,190)

Working Tax Credit run-on (the payment someone receives for a further four weeks after they stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)

Parents can apply for Free School Meals through the <u>Devon Citizens Portal</u> to check their eligibility which provides an instant result although you do need to be in receipt of a qualifying benefit.

Online Safety – 'Wake Up Wednesday'

This week we would like to share with you some games that you can play together with your child to help



make them aware of some online safety issues and open those all-important conversations.

The first one is linked to some resources that we use in Key Stage 2 when teaching online safety, so they should look familiar and could open a conversation about what they have been learning in school. <u>Interland</u> – An educational game made by Google to help teach kids about a range of online safety concerns, it has lessons on cyberbullying, phishing, data protection, and more. Every separate online safety skill is split into a different area in the game and your children get to learn through a variety of minigames and quizzes. Interland is designed for kids aged 8 to 12.

The second one is more suited to younger children. <u>Into the Cloud</u> – A fun, interactive adventure website with videos and activities teaching your children about online safety. Cloud Quest has cartoons that teach online safety skills and is designed for children under the age of 10. We hope you enjoy sharing these resources with your children.
