Educational Visits and Residentials

I have been informed that there are rumours circulating that parents do not need to give voluntary contributions for educational visits and residentials, as they always go ahead anyway. This is not accurate. In the past we have had to cancel visits, much to the disappointment of the children. With the increased pressures on the school budget due to the rising costs everywhere, we are dependent on parents making their voluntary contributions in order to enable these enriching educational experiences to go ahead. The school works hard to try to keep costs low, gains donations from different community groups and the PTFA commits £2 per child each year as a result of their fund-raising activities to help reduce the costs for these activities which enhance the learning and personal development of the children. At present the Dartmoor Residential is over £1500 short; the school simply cannot sustain such losses. We are hoping the remaining contributions will come in over the next week so that this important event for Year 6 can take place, especially when the children have already missed out on so much in the last few years. We understand that sometimes in the busyness of our lives people overlook deadlines and we try to remind you.

The teachers are already planning visits for other year groups for the summer term, but they will only be able to take place if we receive sufficient contributions.
