Parking Issues

With **over 400 children now attending our school**, the roads around the site are busier than ever, especially at drop-off and pick-up times.

Our priority is always the safety of our pupils and the wider community, and we need your help to ensure that the start and end of the school day run smoothly for everyone.

We have recently had reports of cars being hit by other vehicles during drop-off and pick-up times, local residents' driveways being blocked, causing inconvenience and distress and congestion making it difficult for vehicles to access the area.

Please support us by:

- **-Parking considerately**: Do not block driveways or park on pavements
- -Using designated parking areas where possible
- -Keeping speed low and being alert for children crossing
- -Walking, cycling, or scootering to school if you live nearby, please ensure children are wearing helmets if riding bikes / scooters to school.

With such a large school community, Willand School cannot solve these parking and congestion challenges alone

We need everyone's cooperation to keep our children and neighbours safe.

Class and Team Photographs


