Naomi was selected after an in-depth interview process with three very good candidates. She is currently headteacher of St Mary's Church of England Primary School in Bideford and has helped the school to gain a "Good" judgement in their recent Ofsted report. During the interview process Naomi showed she is passionate about our children receiving a high quality, rounded education, supporting and nurturing our staff and working with parents & carers to help our children to achieve as much as they possibly can during their time in Willand School.
