

Online Safety -'Wake Up Wednesday'

'Online Bullying'

This week's free online safety guides focus on Online bullying. Online bullying – also known as cyberbullying – is bullying that takes place ON THE INTERNET (online) or via electronic devices and mobile phones. Latest data from Ofcom, shared on the South West Grid for Learning website, shows that nearly a third of young people aged 8-17 have experienced, or will experience, online bullying.

I'm sharing 2 guides with you this week - one for parents and carers, another for children. The guides look at how to tackle a range of potential risks such as mental wellbeing, distress and sadness. The parent and carer quide highlights a number of tips such as playing online games with your child, talking about your child's online life and being prepared to listen without showing any judgement or criticism.

General Consent Form YR to Y5


