Part A: Curriculum music

At Willand School the music curriculum is informed by the model music curriculum which is available here <u>https://www.gov.uk/government/publications/teaching-music-in-schools</u>.

All children from years 1-6 receive a term of whole class ensemble tuition on the following instruments.

- Year 1 Ukulele
- Year 2 Ocarina
- Year 3 Mini pans
- Year 4 Ukulele
- Year 5 Jumbie Jams

Year 6 – Ukulele

We use the charanga scheme of work to ensure a full coverage of the music curriculum for the other two terms. The weekly music lessons are 45 minutes long. In addition to this there are weekly singing practices and assemblies including collective worship.

A number of visiting musicians visit the school throughout the year to allow pupils to experience live performances. Pupils are also taken to music events in the community.

Our local music hub is the Devon Music Education Hub who we work with on a regular basis and supply the instruments for whole class ensemble tuition.

Part B: Extra-curricular music

Willand School has a choir that runs in both the Autumn and Spring terms. The choir perform at school and within the community at the village hall, care home and over 60's club. Children have the opportunity to perform at class assemblies and productions throughout the year as outlined below:

Harvest Festival - EYFS, KS1 & KS2 - School Hall EYFS - Christmas concert - School Hall KS1 - Nativity - School Hall Whole school - Carol Service - School Hall Willand Christmas Service - Choir - Village Hall Over 60s club – Choir – Church Hall Care Home – Choir - Somerlea Instrumental concert – Years 1 to 6 in the term of their whole class instrumental tuition – School Hall UKS2 Production - KS2 – School Hall

Individual and small group instrumental lessons are provided by a team of self-employed visiting teachers.

We currently have 4 teachers as outlined below: Matt Parr – Drums Scott McGowan – Guitar Franki Lewis – Keyboard/Piano Genevieve Frost – Keyboard/Piano

Parents are billed directly by the instrumental teachers and can be subsidised or free for pupil premium children.

Part C: Musical experiences

Each class at Willand School performs a class assembly for friends and family to attend.

Reception children perform a Christmas showcase.

Years 1 and 2 perform a Nativity.

Years 5 and 6 perform an end of year play.

Singing assemblies happen every week along with collective worship.

A range of other musical opportunities including trips to see live music and visiting musicians coming to our school happen throughout the year.

In the future

In the future we look to change the year 3 whole class instrument from mini pans to recorder.

We would like to bring in a termly performance of the whole class ensemble tuition to the school.
