#### **School Lunches**

Just a reminder that the Dinner Money Arrears Policy says that for accounts that are in debt by £15 or more the school will ask you to provide your child with a packed lunch until the debt has been cleared. This is the total amount owing for the family, not for individual children. If you request further lunches without clearing the

account your child will be given a school packed lunch for which you will be charged the full lunch price, which is currently £2.40.

I would like to take this opportunity to remind you that all lunches must be paid for in advance.

# Children's Holiday Club (HAF - Holidays Activity & Food Programme) Culm Valley Sports Centre

The aim of the HAF programme is to support children to eat more healthily, be more active over the school holidays and have a greater knowledge of health and nutrition as well as be more engaged with school and other local services.

This club runs Monday 19<sup>th</sup> – Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> December, 10am – 2pm for ages 5 - 12, and 3pm - 7pm for ages 12 - 16.

There are limited funded places available that allow children in receipt of benefit related FSM (Free School Meals) a free place. There are also funded places for vulnerable families that may not be in receipt of FSM, children with SEND requirements and children in Foster care. The holiday club is also available to other families for £25 per child per day.
