Class Assembly

Pupil Premium Funding

The pupil premium is additional funding given to statefunded schools in England to raise the attainment of disadvantaged pupils and close the gap between them and their peers.

There are four elements to pupil premium:

-Free school meal eligibility.

-Service children.

-Adopted from care, special guardianship order and residence order.

-Children in care.

Any qualifying family that registers their eligibility (based on the free school meal criteria) will help raise pupil premium money for the school.

Do I need to apply for pupil premium? (based on free school meal criteria)

You only need to apply if you have had a recent change in family/employment circumstances or if your child is in reception, year 1 or year 2 and both of the following apply:

-You do not have an existing free school meal claim. -You are in receipt of any of the qualifying benefits (see <u>School meals</u> for a list of the qualifying benefits). *How to apply*

The <u>Citizen Portal</u> is the quickest and easiest way to apply and will result in you getting an instant decision. Parents and carers can also ring the Education Helpline on $\underline{0345}$ <u>155 1019</u>.

URGENT – September Admission to School

If you have a child who you wish to start at our school in September 2023 and have not already completed an application, it's really important you submit this using the following link: <u>Apply online through the Citizen Portal</u> by **15**th January 2023.

Late applications <u>will not guarantee</u> a place, even if you have a sibling already at Willand School.

If you cannot apply online, please contact the Education helpline on 0345 155 1019 and ask for a paper copy of the form to be sent to you, although the admissions team will need to have received the completed form by the above closing date.
