#### **PTFA funds**

We have been very limited in our fundraising activities this last year due to the pandemic as you may already know. Our last event, the Christmas cards and gift sale were well supported and raised £300 for the school. We hope the childrens lovely artwork gave family and friends a smile and something to treasure despite the 'different' Christmas experienced.

Due to the previous years excellent efforts, we have been able to build a reserve in the PTFA bank account; so, during the Autumn term we were able to donate £2600 to school for a range of resources and experiences to enhance our children's education including funding the bulk of the cost of Theatre Alibi. The incredible Space Odyssey planetarium that Years 5 and 6 experienced was amazing. An equivalent donation was given to each of the other year groups to allow the teachers to organise an experience or resources relating to an area of their curriculum. At the last meeting (January 2021) we have agreed to fund £1000 towards updating Design and Technology resources, a key development area for the school this year. We also agreed to purchase several new sets of headphones to aid KS2 pupils when using Third Space Maths tutoring programme. The school are also working towards the Quality Primary Science Mark and have asked if we can purchase new data loggers which will allow the children to record, display and interpret the results of a range of experiments in an engaging and interactive way (the current ones are over 20 years old.) We shall also be funding 'the updating' of the outside area of Reception and Year 1 classes. In total we shall be donating just under £3000 this term.
